3. Previous Nolin RECC scholarship winners, Nolin RECC employees, directors, or anyone receiving direct benefits from Nolin RECC, and members of their immediate families, are not eligible for any scholarship awards.
4. One scholarship of \$1,500 will be awarded and must be used within two (2) years from the award date.
5. Minimum age requirement for applicant is 21.
